COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 765, L. D. 1031, Bill, "AN ACT to Repeal the Requirement that the Boundary Lines of Voting Districts in Municipal Elections Follow Streets."

Amend said Bill in the Title by striking out the words "to Repeal" and inserting in place thereof the words 'Relating to'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of paragraph A and inserting in place thereof the following:

'A. Territory. Each district shall be formed of compact, contiguous territory and its boundary lines ~~shall~~ may follow the center lines of streets.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of the amendment is to permit municipalities, if they so wish, to have the boundary lines of voting districts in municipal elections to follow streets.
