COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A" to H.P. 773, L.D. 1039, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Disqualification for Benefits under Employment Security Law for Certain Elderly Employees."

Amend said Bill in the next to last line of that part designated paragraph "B." (same in L.D.) by striking out the underlined figure "4" and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '6'

The purpose of this amendment is to provide that the disqualification continues until claimant has earned 6 times his weekly benefit amount.
