STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Eligibility Conditions for Benefits under Employment Security Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 26, § 1192, sub-§ 4, amended. The first sentence of the 2nd paragraph of subsection 4 of section 1192 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 409 of the public laws of 1965, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

Notwithstanding any other provision of this subsection, when he has been paid benefits in his current benefit year equal to 4 times his weekly benefit amount, he shall be eligible to receive benefits as appropriate with respect to the waiting period.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this Act is to provide compensation for a claimant's waiting period in the majority of cases much earlier in his period of unemployment.
