STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Appointments to Housing Authorities.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 4602, sub-§ 1, ¶ D, amended. The last sentence of paragraph D of subsection 1 of section 4602 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

Any public official, elected or appointed, or employee of a municipality in which an authority is established or any other person resident within said municipality may be appointed as a commissioner of the authority. Nothing in this section shall be construed to prevent a commissioner from concurrently serving as a commissioner on a renewal authority established by said municipality.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment would, when desirable, enable a municipality to appoint a public official or employee of said municipality, to serve on a housing authority. Further, this amendment would enable a municipality to promote greater coordination between related agencies in the same community by appointing the same person or persons, when desirable, to serve on both agencies.
