**AN ACT Relating to a Game Warden for the Penobscot Indian Reservation.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1. R. S., T. 12, § 2001, amended.** The first paragraph of section 2001 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding at the end the following sentences:

The commissioner shall also appoint, with the advice and consent of the Penobscot tribal governor and council, subject to the State Personnel Law and civil service regulations, a person as fish and game warden for all lands of the Penobscot Indian Reservation. He shall have the same duties as other wardens and shall enforce all laws, rules and regulations pertaining to fish and game on or off the reservation.

**Sec. 2. Appropriation.** There is appropriated to the Department of Inland Fisheries and Game from the General Fund the sum of \$20,875 to carry out the purposes of this Act.

STATEMENT OF FACT

It is the intent of this bill to provide a game warden for the Penobscot Indian Reservation.
