COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 355, L. D. 1051, Bill,

"AN ACT to Provide Temporary Licenses for Administrators of Medical

Care Facilities Other Than Hospitals."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end of the 7th line (6th line in L. D.) after the amending clause the following:

'Nothing in this chapter or the rules and regulations thereunder shall be construed to require an applicant for a license as a nursing home administrator who is certified by a recognized church or religious denomination which teaches reliance on spiritual means alone for healing as having been approved to administer institutions certified by such church or denomination for the care and treatment of the sick in accordance with its teachings, to demonstrate proficiency in any medical techniques or to meet any medical educational qualifications or medical standards not in accord with the remedial care and treatment provided in such institutions.'

Statement of Fact

It is the purpose of this amendment to prevent spiritual groups from complying with provisions of temporary licenses.
