**AN ACT to Provide Temporary Licenses for Administrators of Medical Care
Facilities Other Than Hospitals.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 32, § 63, sub-§ 7-A, additional. Section 63 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 350 and as amended by section 59-A of chapter 590, both of the public laws of 1969, is further amended by adding a new subsection 7-A to read as follows:

7-A. Temporary licenses. The board may determine conditions and procedures, or establish rules or regulations, by which it may issue temporary licenses to administrators of medical care facilities other than hospitals. Said licenses may be issued for periods of less than one year, but in no event may they be in effect for more than one year, and they may not be renewed or reissued beyond this one-year period.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to amend the Maine law so that federal funds may be received.
