IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Definition of Wholesaler under Liquor Laws.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 28, § 2, sub-§ 24, amended. Subsection 24 of section 2 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
- 24. Wholesaler. "Wholesaler" shall mean and include persons licensed by the commission to engage in the purchase and resale of malt or brewed beverages and vinous liquor in the original containers, as prepared for the market by the manufacturer at the place of manufacture, but not for consumption on the premises of said wholesaler.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to correct an omission in order to include vinous liquor.
