HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 790, L. D. 1066, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Operating a Motor Vehicle without a Current Certificate of Inspection."

Amend said Bill in the 9th line (7th line of L. D.) by inserting after the underlined word "violation" the following: 'if such certificate of inspection has expired within 10 days prior to the violation and'

Further amend said Bill in the next to the last line before the Statement of Fact (same in L. D.) by striking out the figure "12" and inserting in place thereof '24'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide a grace period of 24 hours instead of 12 hours and to provide that the violation occurs within 10 days of the expiration of the certificate of inspection.
