AN ACT Relating to Insurance Trade Practices.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 24-A, § 2172, sub-§ 2, repealed and replaced. Subsection 2 of section 2172 of Title 24-A, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 132 and as amended by section 4 of chapter 402, both of the public laws of 1969, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

2. This section shall not apply as to any bona fide group not organized for the purpose of avoiding this section.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The proposed amendment would permit insurers to issue property, casualty or surety insurance coverage to legitimate groups under terms and conditions, including premiums, which differed from that offered to the general public.
