STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Trustees and Executive Committee of Lincoln Academy.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Lincoln Academy Charter; amended. The last sentence of section 5 of the charter of Lincoln Academy, in Newcastle, incorporated by private and special act of the General Court of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, passed February 23, 1801, and as last amended by section 1 of chapter 227 of the private and special laws of 1965, is further amended to read as follows:

Seven Eight trustees shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.

Sec. 2. Lincoln Academy Charter; amended. The 2nd sentence of section 6 of the charter of Lincoln Academy, in Newcastle, incorporated by private and special act of the General Court of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, passed February 23, 1801, and as last amended by section 3 of chapter 17 of the private and special laws of 1961, is further amended to read as follows:

The executive committee shall consist of the officers, the immediate past president and 3 members.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to increase the quorum of the trustees of Lincoln Academy from 7 to 8 and to add the immediate past president of the trustees to the executive committee.
