STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to **Conferring Degrees by Christian Academy of Glen
Cove.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Degrees. Christian Academy, by appropriate action of its trustees, may confer upon all who shall satisfactorily complete such courses as said trustees may prescribe, within the scope customarily established by colleges offering a 4-year curriculum in liberal arts, baccalaureate degrees in religious education and such honorary degrees, literary titles, honors and certificates of proficiency as are usually conferred by like institutions of higher learning.

Sec. 2. Effective date. The first degrees to be awarded will be in June, 1971.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to permit Christian Academy to confer the baccalaureate degree in religious education.
