STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Fees for Recording Marriage Intentions and Issuing License.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 30, § 2352, sub-§ 2, amended. Subsection 2 of section 2352 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
- 2. Marriage intentions and license. Recording marriage intentions and issuing a marriage license, \$\frac{1}{2}\$ \$10; except, where the laws of this State require 2 licenses, the fee shall be \$5.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The existing fee for marriages is insufficient to cover the cost of issuing the license and presently discriminates against the couple who are required to obtain 2 licenses.
