STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to the Sale of Alcoholic Beverages at the Bangor International Airport.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 28, § 55, sub-§ 21, additional. Section 55 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new subsection 21, to read as follows:
- 21. Bangor International Airport. Notwithstanding any other provision of law the commission is authorized to adopt rules, requirements and regulations permitting alcoholic beverages to be served at restaurant facilities of Bangor International Airport to international travelers in transit between the time of arrival and departure of international flights.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Unscheduled flights frequently land at the Bangor International Airport during hours which alcoholic beverages are not permitted to be served. The intent of this legislation is to permit the sale of such beverages to passengers during these hours at the terminal facilities.
