COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A" to H. P. 820, L. D. 1094, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to the Location of Solid Waste Disposal Areas."

Amend said Bill by inserting before the underlined words
"body of water" in the 7th line (5th line of L. D.) the under-
lined word 'classified'

Further amend said Bill in the 9th line (7th in L.D.)
after the amending clause by inserting before the underlined
words "body of water" the underlined word 'classified'

Further amend said Bill in the last line of the 3rd
paragraph in that part designated "§ 421." by inserting before
the underlined words "body of water" the underlined word
'classified'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the 5th
paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Any solid waste disposal area whose boundary is closer
than 300 feet to any classified body of water shall be
discontinued in conformity with this section prior to
December 1, 1973.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to make it clear that
dumps cannot be located close to a formal body of water rather
than to all collections of water which in many cases are nothing
more than seasonal drains. Virtually every formal body of water
in the State is now classified, and also to not require the

physical removal of refuse in dumps established prior to this Act but merely to require their discontinuance.
