Amend said Bill in the first line of section 2 (same in
L. D.) by striking out the following:"3rd" and inserting in
place thereof '4th'

Further amend said Bill in the first line after the
amending clause in section 3 (same in L.D.) by striking out
the underlined figure "10" and inserting in place thereof the
underlined figure '21'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to require the Attorney
General to enforce orders of the Environmental Improvement
Commission within 21 days and also to correct a typographical
error in the bill.
