COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S. P. 363, L. D. 1102, Bill,  
"AN ACT to Regulate the Harvesting of Fiddleheads on Penobscot  
Reservation Lands."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the first paragraph  
of that part designated "§4793." and inserting in place thereof  
the following:

'No person other than members of the Penobscot tribe of Indians  
shall be permitted to harvest fiddleheads on any lands of the  
Penobscot tribe except by permission of private landowners.'

Statement of Fact

It is the intent of this amendment to clarify provisions  
of the bill as to harvesting with permission of private landowners.
