SENATE AMENDMENT " B " to S.P. 363, L.D. 1102, Bill, "AN
ACT to Regulate the Harvesting of Fiddleheads on Penobscot
Reservation Lands."


Amend said Bill by striking out all of the second underlined
paragraph of that part designated "§4793." and inserting in place
thereof the following underlined paragraph:

'Any person found in violation of this section shall be
subject to a fine of not more than \$100. All fines collected
for the above offense shall be returned to the Penobscot Tribe.'
