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**AN ACT Providing Funds to Preserve the Machias Valley Airport.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Machias Valley Airport; funds for.** There is appropriated the sum of \$5,000 from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to the Maine Department of Aeronautics for the following purposes at the Machias Valley Airport:

To construct a pavement overlay over the following airport surfaces: Runway 2500' x 50'; taxiway 150' x 20'; apron 100' x 100'.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The Machias Valley Airport was constructed in 1964 and has since proven to be a very important transportation facility. The existing pavements associated with the above referred-to airport surfaces have reached a state of deterioration that, to preserve and insure safe use by aircraft, improvements are essential. These improvements would be the construction of a pavement overlay over the surfaces described and the total project cost has been estimated at \$20,000. This cost would be shared as follows:

State of Maine .....	25%	or \$ 5,000
Machias .....	25%	or \$ 5,000
U. S. Government .....	50%	or \$10,000
