COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 836, L. D. 1132, Bill,
"AN ACT Providing Funds to Expand Homemaker Services in the
Department of Health and Welfare."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the
enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Department of Health and Welfare; appropriation. There
is appropriated to the Department of Health and Welfare from the
General Fund the sum of \$70,300 to provide for the expansion of
its homemaker services. The breakdown shall be as follows:
