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**AN ACT** Relating to Powers and Duties of School Directors.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 20, § 306, amended.** The first paragraph of section 306 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end the following new sentence:

The school directors may join, cooperate and associate with the educational units within the State and create a separate legal identity when necessary to make application for, receive and implement federal, state, local or private grants for the purpose of supplementary educational programs within the School Administrative District.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide a means for administrative units to organize under cooperative agreements to carry out special educational functions which can more effectively be carried out on a regional basis.
