
SENATE AMENDMENT " B " to H. P. 1084, L. D. 1150, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Trespass on Certain State Institutions."

Amend said Bill in the 6th line (5th in L.D.) after the amending clause by inserting before the underlined word "whoever" the following: 'whoever wilfully trespasses upon land or buildings owned or occupied by any municipality or school administrative district, or whoever wilfully refuses to leave land or buildings owned or occupied by any municipality or school administrative district after being requested to do so by a municipal officer of the municipality or school director, superintendent or principal in a school administrative district, or by any police officer having jurisdiction to arrest in the municipality where the land or building is located, sheriff, or deputy sheriff or'

It is the intent of this amendment to include land and buildings of a municipality or school administrative district.
