## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Trespass on Certain State Institutions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 17, § 3851, repealed and replaced. Section 3851 of Title 17 of the Revised Statues, as last amended by section 25 of chapter 504 of the public laws of 1969, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

§ 3851. Lands appurtenant to state institutions

Whoever willfully trespasses upon lands or buildings which belong to the State and are appurtenant to the correctional, educational or health institutions of the State, or whoever shall unlawfully interfere with security personnel, inmates or persons served by said institutions, or, whoever willfully trespasses upon land or buildings of the University of Maine, after notice from security personnel of said institutions or the University of Maine or from employees designated by the director of said institutions or the University of Maine to leave said land or buildings, remains thereon, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$50 or by imprisonment for not more than 3 months, or by both.
