STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Uniforms for Full-time Deputy Sheriffs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 951, amended. The last sentence of section 951 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 379 of the public laws of 1965, is amended to read as follows:

The number of uniforms to be furnished the sheriff and all full-time deputies in each county shall be as follows: Androscoggin, ## 15; Aroostook, 6 10; Cumberland, #8 22; Franklin, #8; Hancock, \$9; Kennebec, 8 12; Knox, 6 10; Lincoln, \$7; Oxford, #2 16; Penobscot, #2 16; Piscataquis, \$7; Sagadahoc, \$7; Somerset, #8; Waldo, \$9; Washington, #9 and York, \$9 13.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The increase in allotted uniforms is to compensate for the additional personnel employed by the sheriffs' departments within the past 2 years.
