AN ACT Relating to Course of Study in Secondary Schools.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 20, § 1281, sub-§ 1, amended. Subsection 1 of section 1281 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

1. **Course of study approved.** It maintains a course of study approved by the commissioner. **The course of study is organized to meet the individual needs of pupils.**

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide that the course of study in secondary schools should be flexible.
