**AN ACT Prohibiting Use of Motor Vehicles on Frozen Surface of Part of
Sasanoa River.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Motor vehicles prohibited on frozen surface of part of Sasanoa River. It is unlawful to operate a motor vehicle on the frozen surface of Sasanoa River in the area from Hell's Gate north to the Kennebec River and Route # 1.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to protect life and property of the smelt fishermen and to cause less noise and motion which tend to frighten schools of smelts.
