AN ACT to Limit the Number of Lobster Traps Per Lobster and Crab License.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 4404-A, additional. Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 4404-A to read as follows:

§ 4404-A. No lobster and crab licensee may fish more than 600 traps

It is unlawful for any person to fish more than 600 traps for lobsters and crabs at any one time.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this Act is to limit the number of lobster traps by any licensee.
