AN ACT Regulating Lobster Traps on Trawls.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 4467, additional. Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 4467 to read as follows:

§ 4467. Lobster traps

It is unlawful to have on any trawl more than 2 lobster traps on one warp and buoy in any of the tidal waters of this State.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to aid in the conservation of the Maine lobster industry.
