COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A" to H. P. 851, L. D. 1164, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Aiding Injured Persons and Reporting Hunting
Accidents."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 1.

Further amend said Bill in section 2 by striking out the
first 2 paragraphs in that part designated "§ 2954." and
inserting before the 3rd paragraph the following:

'Any person who knows that he has inflicted injury or has
reason to know that he may have inflicted injury to another
person by the use of firearms or bow and arrow shall make
himself known to the victim and shall render such first aid and
assistance as he is capable of rendering under the circumstances,
and shall thereupon give notice of the event by the quickest
means to a state police officer, sheriff, game warden or
other law enforcement officer nearest the place where the
event occurred.'

Further amend said Bill by renumbering sections 2 and 3 to
be sections 1 and 2.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to delete the first section
of the bill and reword the section dealing with aiding injured
persons.
