Amend said Amendment by inserting after section 2 the following:

'Sec. 3. Agreements. The Towns of Cumberland and Yarmouth
shall negotiate an agreement whereby provision shall be made for
the use and maintenance of the landing and provision shall be made
for the parking on Cousin's Island of motor vehicles owned by
Chebeague residents.'
