COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S. P. 400, L. D. 1175,
Bill, "AN ACT to Provide for New Ferry Landings at Cousin's
Island or Littlejohns Island and Chebeague Island."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the title and
inserting in place thereof the following: 'AN ACT to Provide
for Repair of Cousin's Island landing in the Town of Yarmouth
and used by Chebeague Island in the Town of Cumberland'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of sections
1 and 2 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 1. Repair landing. The Maine Port Authority is
authorized and directed to repair the landing in the Town of
Yarmouth for use of Chebeague Island in the Town of Cumberland.
The \$10,000 as herein provided shall pay part of the cost and
the balance to be paid by Cumberland County and the Town of
Cumberland. The county shall contribute 2/3 of the additional cost
and Cumberland 1/3.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section 3
and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriations. There is appropriated from the
Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to the Maine Port
Authority the sum of \$10,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30,
1972 to carry out the purposes of this Act. Such appropriation
shall not lapse but shall be carried forward into the 1972 to 1973
year to be used for the same purpose.'
