STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT to Provide for New Ferry Landings at Cousin's Island or Littlejohns Island and Chebeague Island.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. Construction. The Maine Port Authority is authorized and directed to construct a new ferry landing for the movement of vehicles and passengers, either on Cousin's Island or Littlejohns Island, in its discretion, and a new ferry landing for the movement of vehicles and passengers on Chebeague Island at or near the present landing known as the Stone Pier.
- Operational and maintenance costs. Annual rental shall be paid to the State of Maine. Operational and maintenance costs will be paid for under a lease between the port authority and any carrier authorized by the Maine Public Utilities Commission to operate in Casco Bay and to use said landings in the operation of its service.
- Sec. 3. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to the Maine Port Authority the sum of \$100,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1972 to carry out the purposes of this Act.
