L. D. 1181, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Sale Price of Liquor."

Amend said Amendment by inserting at the end of the 7th line
before the period the following underlined words: 'and establish
at that store the price to which the 10% discount in section 204
shall be applicable'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment would allow the State Liquor
Commission to utilize its discretion in reducing prices in order to
effectively meet competition from liquor stores in other jurisdictions
located around the borders of the State of Maine and establish
at that store a price to which the discount of 10% in section 204
of Title 28 shall apply.
