COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 856, L. D. 1181, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Sale Price of Liquor."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the last sentence before the Statement of Fact and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Notwithstanding the other provisions of this section, the commission, with the approval of the Commissioner of Finance and Administration, may reduce the price of liquor in one store.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment would allow the State Liquor Commission to utilize its discretion in reducing prices in order to effectively meet competition from liquor stores in other jurisdictions located around the borders of the State of Maine. Price reduction would be limited to one store in a highly competitive location.
