AN ACT Relating to Secondary Education in the Town of Rangeley.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows.

Town of Rangeley; authorized to operate high school. Notwithstanding the Revised Statutes, Title 20, section 1281, subsection 10, the Town of Rangeley is authorized to operate a high school even though the enrollment is less than 100 pupils, except that such authorization shall expire July 1, 1973.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to permit the Town of Rangeley to operate its high school even though its enrollment may be less than 100 pupils, with the proviso that the authorization expires July 1, 1973.
