**AN ACT Repealing Limitation on Number of Examinations for Admission
to Practice Law.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 4, § 805, amended. The 2nd sentence of the first paragraph and all of the last paragraph of section 805 of Title 4 of the Revised Statutes, are repealed.
