AN ACT Relating to Late Filing of Answers to Petition for Award under
Workmen's Compensation Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 39, § 97, amended. Section 97 of Title 39 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new paragraph at the end to read as follows:

Except that for good cause shown, a single commissioner may permit the late filing of any pleading permissible under this Act.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to permit a single Industrial Accident Commissioner to allow late filing of pleadings under Workmen's Compensation Act.
