RESOLVE, Appropriating Funds to Prevent Sawdust Pollution at South Branch Lake and Saponac Pond in Penobscot County.

Sawdust pollution at South Branch Lake and Saponac Pond prevented. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$2,000 to the Towns of Burlington, Grand Falls and Seboeis Plantation to remove old accumulations of sawdust at South Branch Lake and Saponac Pond and to prevent further pollution.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The intent of this Resolve is to provide \$2,000 to clean up old accumulations of sawdust on 2 lakes which continuously pollute the waters. Applying \$1,000 to each lake matched by the towns and interested citizens this source of pollution can be removed.
