STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Use of Motor Vehicle Dealer Registration Plates.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 29, § 336, sub-§ 5, ¶ F, amended. Paragraph F of subsection 5 of section 336 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 6 of chapter 400 of the public laws of 1969, is amended to read as follows:
 - F. For the use of full-time salesmen, general managers, sales managers or service managers who are on the dealer's payroll as such, but not the immediate family or member of the household of said salesmen general managers, sales managers or service managers.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to limit the use of motor vehicle dealer registration plates to full-time salesmen.
