HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to S. P. 404, L. D. 1221, Bill,  
"AN ACT Creating the Cumberland County Recreation Center."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 5 a new section 5-A  
to read as follows:

'Sec. 5-A. Preliminary planning and site selection. Upon  
appointment of the 9 trustees of the district, the Cumberland  
County Board of Commissioners are authorized to provide to the  
trustees from the unappropriated surplus of Cumberland County a  
sum not to exceed \$25,000; said sum to be used by the trustees to  
employ such consultants, planners, architects, engineers, individuals  
or firms as they deem necessary to prepare preliminary sketches,  
plans and renderings of the proposed recreation center and to  
study and prepare recommendations on possible sites within  
Cumberland County on which the proposed recreation center could be  
located. Such preliminary sketches, costs, plans, renderings,  
studies and recommendations to be completed and presented to the  
trustees no later than 60 days prior to the referendum referred to  
in this Act.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the end of the first  
paragraph of the Referendum the following sentence:

'The Cumberland County Board of Commissioners are authorized to  
expend such funds as are necessary to implement the referendum.'
