COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 407, L.D. 1223, Bill, "AN ACT Empowering the Environmental Improvement Commission to Conduct Studies Relating to Noise Pollution."

Amend said Bill in section 1 in that part designated "§471." by striking out in the 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th lines (2nd, 3rd and 4th in L.D.) the following underlined words and punctuation: "provide technical assistance to political subdivisions and industries which are endeavoring to reduce, control or eliminate noise;"

Further amend said Bill in section 3 by striking out in the 4th line and again in the 8th line (3rd and 8th in L.D.) the figure "\$30,000" and inserting in place thereof the figure '\$5,000'

Statement of Fact

It is the purpose of this amendment to reduce the cost of the noise pollution study which this Bill would authorize.
