HOUSE AMENDMENT 'A " to S. P. 407, L. D. 1223, Bill, "AN ACT Empowering the Environmental Improvement Commission to Conduct Studies Relating to Noise Pollution."

Amend said Bill in section 1 in that part designated "§ 472." by inserting at the end before the period the underlined words 'and except that this requirement shall not apply to legal entities which are subject to the requirements of the Federal Walsh-Healy Act'
