COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 890, L. D. 1229, Bill,
"AN ACT to Create the Bangor Parking Authority."

Amend said Bill in section 4 by adding at the end of the first paragraph of subsection 5 before the period the following:
' , except that ways or highways crossing over any railroad track or through or across any land or right-of-way of any railroad corporation shall be subject to same provisions as the location of town ways provided in the Revised Statutes, Title 23, section 2902'

Further amend said Bill in section 4 by striking out in the 3rd line of the last paragraph (same in L. D.) the word "other"

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify eminent domain as to railroads.
