## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 105TH LEGISLATURE

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 414, L. D. 1230, Bill, "AN ACT Creating a Medical Advisory Board for Medical Criteria and Vision Standards for Motor Vehicle Drivers."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "§547." by inserting at the end of subsection 1 the following underlined sentence:

'Such board shall consist of a psychiatrist, an optometrist, an ophthalmologist, a medical physician and a citizen at large.'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§547." by striking out all of subsection 4.

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of subsection 5 of that part designated "§547." and inserting in place thereof the following:

'4. Confidential. Reports received or made by the board, or its members, for the purpose of assisting the department in determining whether a person is qualified to be licensed, are for the confidential use of the board or the department and may not be divulged to any person except the licensed driver shall receive a copy of the report.'
