STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Discrimination under the Personnel Law Because of Age.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 5, § 553, amended. Section 553 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

§ 553. Discrimination

In carrying out chapters 51 to 61, no discrimination shall be made on account of political or religious opinions or affiliations or because of race or national origin, sex or marital status or age.

STATEMENT OF FACT

It is the intent of this legislation to prohibit discrimination under the personnel law for reason of age.
