IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Conferring Baccalaureate Degrees by John F. Kennedy College

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Baccalaureate Degrees; John F. Kennedy College. Notwithstanding the Revised Statutes, Title 20, section 2203, John F. Kennedy College in Fort Kent may in addition to the rights, privileges and powers granted by the private and special laws of 1967, chapter 102, by appropriate action of its trustes, confer upon all who shall satisfactorily complete such courses of study as said trustees may prescribe, within the scope customarily established by colleges offering a 4-year curriculum, baccalaureate degrees and such honorary degrees, literary titles, honors and certificates of proficiency as are usually conferred by like institutions of higher learning.
