#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

## AN ACT to Provide Funds to Improve the Wiscasset Airport.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Wiscasset Airport; funds for. There is appropriated the sum of \$60,000 from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to the Maine Department of Aeronautics for the following purposes at Wiscasset Airport:

Construct a 600' extension on runway 7-25

(from 3,400' to 4,000')

Construct a new secondary cross-wind

runway (50' x 2,200')

\$140,000

\$100,000

TOTAL \$240,000

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

This cost would be shared as follows:

State of Maine

25% or \$ 60,000 25% or \$ 60,000 Lincoln County or Wiscasset

U. S. Government 50% or \$120,000

TOTAL \$240,000

The Wiscasset Airport was originally developed in 1958. Since its inception, it has shown a progressive and substantial increase in aviation activity. Services now offered include flight training, air taxi service, student instruction, fuel and aircraft maintenance and repairs.

It can be rationally stated that the Wiscasset Airport represents a very important transportation facility to a large area which includes, among others, the municipalities of Wiscasset, Bath, and Boothbay Harbor.
