STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Board of Visitors for Each State Institution Under the Department of Mental Health and Corrections.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 34, § 41, amended. The first sentence of section 41 of Title 34 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

A board of 5 visitors, as heretofore established, at least 2 of whom shall be members of the minority party, may shall be appointed by the Governor, in connection with each institution under the department.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to change the present law so that a board of visitors for each state institution under the Department of Mental Health and Corrections shall be appointed.
