AN ACT Relating to Use of Power Boats on Parks Pond,
Penobscot County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 38, § 247, additional. Title 38 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 247 to read as follows:

§ 247. Parks Pond, Penobscot County

No person, except officers empowered to enforce this subchapter, shall operate a motorboat having more than 10 horsepower on Parks Pond, Town of Clifton, Penobscot County.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Parks Pond is a small pond in eastern Penobscot County and the camp owners would like to keep the surroundings tranquil and safe by keeping out large horsepower motors.
