SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 906,
L.D. 1250, Bill, "AN ACT Establishing a State-wide Open Deer
Season for the First Three Weeks in November."

Amend said Amendment by inserting before the last paragraph
the following:

'Sec. 4. Application. Notwithstanding any other provision
of law, the 1971 deer hunting season shall terminate on November 21,
1971.'

Further amend said Amendment in the next to last line by
striking out the underlined abbreviation and figure "Sec. 4."
and inserting in place thereof the underlined abbreviation and
figure 'Sec. 5.'
